





Charlotte loves **Do Not Open This Book** by Andy Lee and Heath McKenzie, published by Lake Press.




Emma loves Captain Underpants by Dav Pilkey, published by Scholastic.






On this episode, we give a shout out to the Children's Book Council of Australia Illawarra-South Coast sub-branch fundraising dinner.


INTRODUCING THE 104-STOREY TREEHOUSE






Listener Question
