Sarah's first book as author, illustrator AND designer will be released by HarperCollins in 2019. She is also proud to be an ambassador for **Room to Read**, and the Illustrator Coordinator for the Society of Children's Book Writers and Illustrators (Australia East/NZ), also known as **SCBWI**.

In addition to her illustration work, Sarah is now Associate Art Director at Walker Books Australia.




