

## Kids Capers - Talking to Library Monitors


Nat talks to library monitors Evie and Lila about the true magic of libraries - BOOKS! Here are their favourites...



**Julianne Negri** is a library programmer for children and teens, and has previously been a musician, eco-crafter, television host, screenwriter and filmmaker.



Kate gives a shout out to **The Ampersand Prize** which is Australia and New Zealand's premier award for unpublished writers of middle-grade and young adult fiction.


