Gus Gordon is an internationally acclaimed illustrator and author.

He has illustrated and written over 80 books for children. His books which include *Wendy, Herman and Rosie* (2013 CBCA Honour book), *Somewhere Else* (2017 Speech Pathology book of the year), *The Last Peach* and *Finding François* have sold in over 20 countries worldwide and have received wide international recognition.


He has been shortlisted for the German Youth Literature Award, the Sakura Medal in Japan, the Kirico book awards in Spain, the Les Incorruptibles prize in France, the Premio Anderson Children's Book award in Italy and has twice been nominated for the Astrid Lindgren Memorial Award, the world's largest award for children's and young adult literature.

He lives with his wife and three kids in Sydney, Australia.



Lucinda Gifford is the author and illustrator of many well-loved books for kids.

Her books include *Whitney and Britney Chicken Divas* (chosen for National Simultaneous Storytime 2020), *The Monty's Island* series written by Emily Rodda, and *The Adventures of Princess Peony* series by Nette Hilton – as well as *The Fourteenth Summer of Angus Jack* by Jen Storer, and the picture book *Saved!!!* written by Matilda's goalkeeper Lydia Williams.

Her latest book (as author and illustrator) is The Wolves of Greycoat Hall, a junior fiction novel published by Walker Books.

Lucinda lives with her family in Melbourne's northern suburbs and works as an author and illustrator from her home studio. She plans to write and draw for the rest of her life, or until her hand drops off, or both.
