Alongside creating award-winning picture books, Liz paints murals and makes illustrated maps. She is a Board Director of Australia Society of Authors, on CBCA and SCBWI committees and reviews books for CBCA Reading Time. Her picture book *Dry to Dry* is shortlisted for the CBCA Eve Pownall Information Book of the Year 2021 and will be on exhibition at Lovett Gallery, Newcastle from beginning of July.





Felice Arena is one of Australia's much-loved children's authors.

His books have topped bestseller lists and garnered several awards, including six Australian Children Choice Book Awards. Some of these include the *Andy Roid* series, the *Sporty Kids & The Besties* books, the hugely popular *Specky Magee* series, his acclaimed historical adventure novels and CBCA notable books *The Boy and the Spy*, *Fearless Frederic* and *A Great Escape* and most recently his perfect read-aloud picture book *Poo And Other Words That Make Me Laugh!*

Felice's books have also been published in the UK, USA, Ireland, New Zealand, Vietnam, Taiwan, Japan, and China.

In October 2020 Felice was honoured with the YABBA's Graham Davey Citation Award for his contribution to Australian children's literature.
