

Harriet Muncaster is the author and illustrator of the internationally bestselling Isadora Moon series of young reader books and the middle-grade Victoria Stitch series, both published by Oxford University Press.

So far Isadora Moon is available in thirty-five different languages, including Spanish, Italian, Romanian and Korean, and is available as audio books. The Isadora Moon series won the El Corte Inglés Children's Book of the Year in 2019 and has sold over 2 million copies worldwide.

Kate interviews Clare Weze




