

Her debut junior fiction novel *The Secrets of Magnolia Moon* (Walker Books) was awarded the CBCA Honour Book of the Year for Younger Readers, and shortlisted for the Readings' Children's Book Prize. She has received three CBCA Notables for her picture books.

Edwina lives in country Victoria with her husband, two children, and too many animals. She divides her time between writing and working in youth mental health.




ROSE RECOMMENDS:

Rose is 8 and loves all things creative. When she is not reading, she loves playing piano, drawing, drama and listening to the Beatles and Harry Styles.


She would love her favourite authors to run the country, particularly Tim Harris and Nat Amoore.


